The M.S. requirements are designed to provide maximum flexibility to accommodate individual student interests while also assuring a basic level of competence within Marine Science. Core courses must be passed with a grade of ‘B’ or better. M.S. candidates follow an integrated course of study recommended by their thesis advisor and thesis committee. The thesis committee will be nominated by the end of the first year in consultation with the student and the thesis advisor. It will consist of 3 faculty from the Interdepartmental Program, with the major professor serving as Chair.*
