A minimum of **31.0 units** is required for the Ph.D. The Ph.D. requirements are designed to provide maximum flexibility to accommodate individual student interests while also assuring a basic level of competence within Marine Science. Ph.D. candidates follow an integrated course of study recommended by their dissertation advisor and dissertation committee. The dissertation committee will be nominated by the end of the second year in consultation with the student and the dissertation advisor/major professor. It will consist of at least 3 UC Academic Senate faculty, 2 of whom must be from the Program, with the thesis advisor/major professor serving as Chair. Time-to-Degree: 3 years to advance to candidacy, 6 years to complete the degree.
